Alcohol


Illegal substances

- We will have stewards patrolling the site all through the night. If you need any assistance, please ask one of the stewards.
- There will be a first aider on site throughout the event.
- Please respect the fact that once midnight comes, people will be trying to sleep, so noise and activity should be kept to an absolute minimum.
- Anyone at the Sleep Out who is not behaving in the spirit of the event, or is engaged in an activity which is detrimental to the experience of the other participants, will be asked to leave forthwith.



Non-Sleepers are most welcome to enjoy the food and the entertainment for an entrance charge of £15 but are asked to leave after the entertainment has finished around 11.00pm
